All phones must remain off and put up unless you are given permission to have them out. If you have been given permission to use your phone during class you are NOT allowed to text, call, or engage in social media.

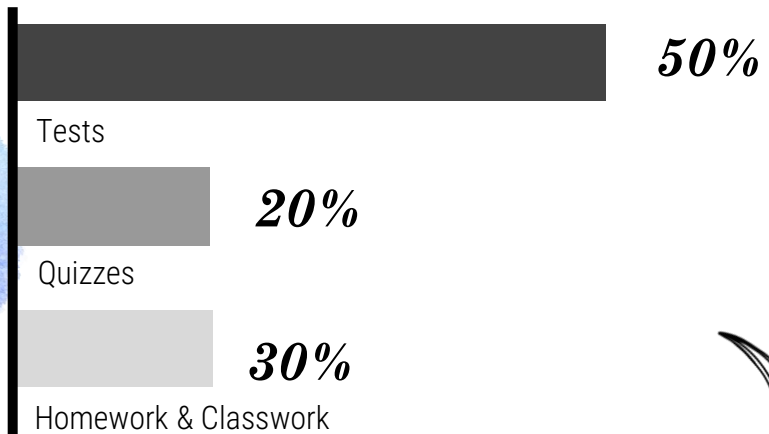
If you have a DCPS issued laptop, please bring it to school each day (fully charged).
